Products that can be used repeatedly. Use over disposable products to reduce the amount of waste and help sustain the environment for future generations.



A biodegradable product has the abilitity to break down, safely and relatively quickly by biological means, into the raw materials of nature and disappear into the environment.



Fairtrade changes the way trade works through better prices, decent working conditions and a fairer deal for farmers and workers in developing countries.



Recyclable materials are made of raw materials that can be reprocessed and used again. Such materials include glass, paper, metal, and limited types of plastic.



Organic materials do not rely on synthetic pesticides, herbicides and fertilizers that can deplete the soil of valuable nutrients and increase environmental degradation.



Recycling is the process of collecting and processing materials that would otherwise be thrown away as trash and turning them into new products. Recycling prevents and reduces the consumption of fresh raw materials.



Ethical materials products are manufacturered without using process material, person or animal in an unethical or immoral way.

Bambook is produced locally by hand at a sheltered workshop in Ede, the Netherlands. You book is put together with love and care by people who are disadvantaged from entering the labour market. Hardcover Bambook







Softcover Bambook

The paper inside this notebook is also made from Vibers, a fibre produced from elephant grass. This notebook is also created on Dutch soil – so we're making good use of the Dutch manufacturing industry while at the same time transporting the product as short a distance as possible.

Elephant grass is a special plant that grows in the Netherlands. It absorbs 4 times as much CO2 as a forest of trees, and grows on poor soil without the use of pesticides.

Recycled Leather Notebook

These A5 notebooks are made from recycled Kraft paper covers with an elastic closure, elastic pen loop and ribbon in various colours.












Coffee Waste Notebook
